Statement

Bosco Centre is an inclusive educational and leisure establishment, which welcomes all young people particularly from the local community but also from all other areas of Southwark and nearer Boroughs

Bosco College is open to those young people who wish to follow our programmes of study, provided we can meet their educational and social needs, and who are between 16/ 17 at the start of the academic year.

We particularly welcome:

- 16 / 17 year olds who have experienced barriers to their learning as a result of external circumstances and have failed to reach their potential.
- Teenage parents who are motivated to further their education in one of our vocational fields. (We have additional facilities for childcare).
- Students with an ECH2 Certificate and those who have “High Needs”

We also take school- aged learners who have been referred to us:

- from local schools, who for various reasons, have been unable to follow their school curriculum,
- From the Local Authority or
- from parents, who we in turn have referred to the LA

This is provided we can meet the educational and social needs of the young person. Leadership for High Needs and EHC2 Learners is the responsibility of the Director, who may delegate certain activities and responsibilities to different members of staff. As this is a small but very important area of the work The Director will cascade to staff members the profile of those with “High Needs” and their part in the provision for them
